PROPOSED ROUTE SUMMARY

Route 144 will run between North Springs Station to Georgia State University's Alpharetta campus via., GA-400, North Point Pkwy., Haynes Bridge Rd., Westside Pkwy., Morris Rd., Webb Rd., and Brookside Pkwy. This proposed route will have a midday frequency of **40 minutes**. For more details, refer to the table below.

The alignment of this route contains segments of existing Routes 140, 141 and 185. The segments between GA-400 and North Point Pkwy.'s intersection with Haynes Bridge Rd. that are currently served by Routes 140 and 141 will now be served by this route and Route 143. This route will provide service to Avalon and Windward Park & Ride then serve the segment of North Point Pkwy. between Old Milton Pkwy. and Morris Rd. currently served by Route 140. It will also serve the segments east of North Point Pkwy. that are currently served by Route 185.
