Smarter

Redesigned bus network that is easier to navigate.

It will enhance the travel experience by providing a more dependable, accessible, and connected bus system – improving access to jobs, education, and essential services.

Faster

Reach more places in less time.

Better aligned service that features streamlined routes, higher frequencies, and more direct connections to jobs and other regional destinations.

A more flexible, accessible, and faster bus system.

Greater accessibility to more destinations systemwide with new on-demand service launching in key zones.

18 Corridors with 15-Minute Frequency

Consistent Service 7-Days-A-Week

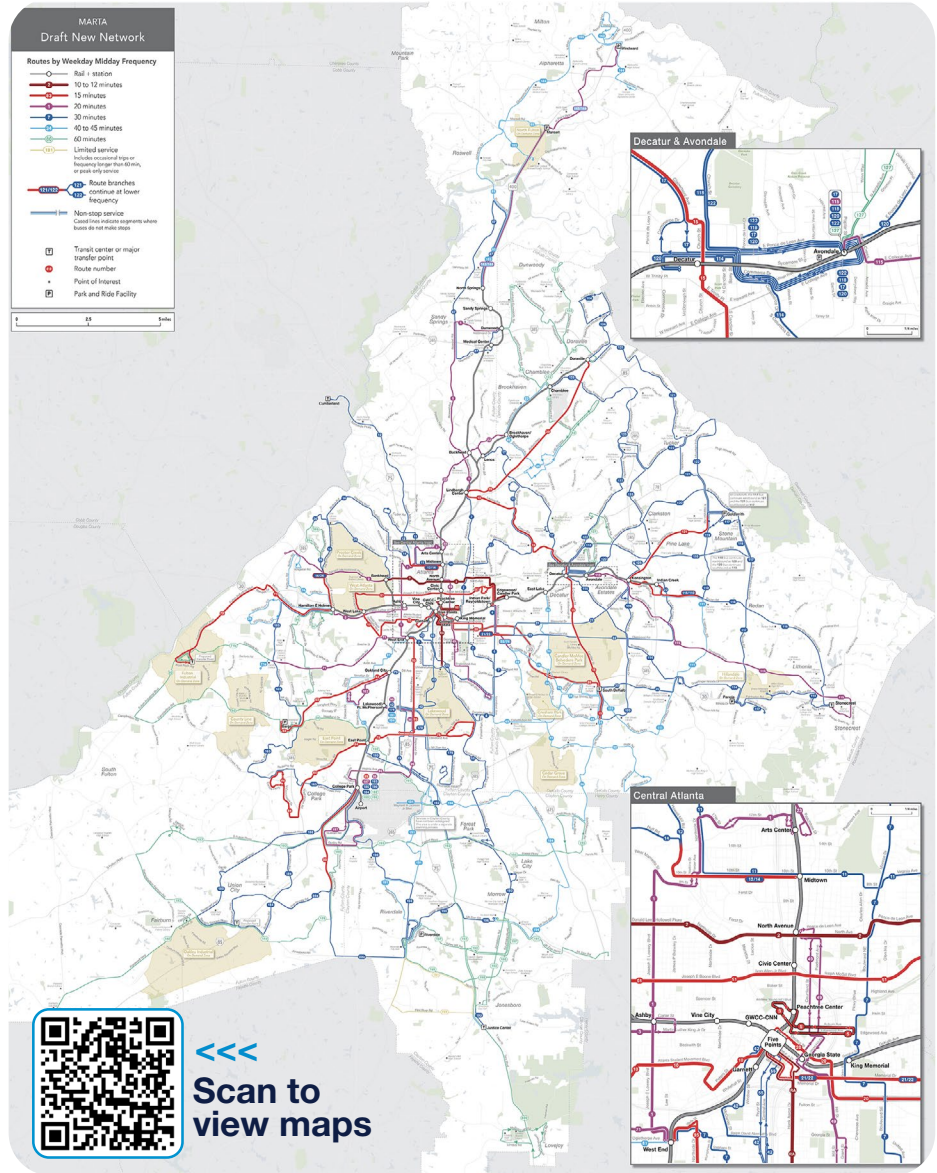
All bus routes and on-demand zones will operate daily

Additional Network Highlights

The draft network features 79 routes, including 18 high-frequency corridors (shown in red). Many lower-frequency routes are designed to make timed connections for quicker trips and include 12 on-demand transit zones.
